Choreographer - Yoko Young



The late Yoko Young was born in Tokyo and began studying dance at the age of four, beginning with Fujima (traditional Japanese dancing). She went on to study classical ballet under Sakiko Hirose of the Tokyo Ballet, Sulamith Messere and Aleksei Varilamov of the Bolshoi Ballet and Roy Tobias of the New York City Ballet. She was Prima Ballerina and soloist for the

Hirose Ballet Company and Tokyo Ballet Theatre in such standards as Swan Lake, Sleeping Beauty, Don Quixote and many more. She danced Carmen with the Opera de Paris in France.

Yoko established her own dance studio in 1995 and earned the title "The Best Studio In The West" her very first year. Over the years Yoko's superb teaching earned her numerous awards and recognition. Her studio was selected as one of the Top 50 Studios in the Nation by Dance Spirit magazine and made the cover of Time For Kids magazine. Some of her biggest accomplishments included being featured as the cover story for Dance Teacher magazine, and choreographing for the Super Bowl halftime show at Texas Stadium, featuring singer Sheryl Crow with Yoko's students as her background dancers. Yoko also put together three ambassador tours to Japan in which her students represented the city of Fremont at celebrations in Fukaya; her students also performed in London during the Summer Olympics there.

An accomplished choreographer, Yoko choreographed musicals such as Once Upon A Mattress, Little Mary Sunshine, Annie, The Wizard of Oz, An Evening With Rodgers and Hammerstein, and Peter Pan and traveled to Japan with some of them.

In 2005, Yoko choreographed Tchaikovsky's complete Nutcracker ballet. Her production of the Nutcracker was the first full scale performance of a ballet in Fremont and has become an annual tradition for the city.

Both girls graduated from UCLA, having worked and danced in Los Angeles for many years before ultimately moving back to Northern California to work alongside Yoko at Yoko's Dance and Performing Arts Academy. They have been

teaching and choreographing for Yoko's Dance for sixteen years, receiving many awards for their choreography and routines. Most recently, Erin and Megan received recognition for three of the pieces they choreographed which all won the coveted award of National Champion in 2018. Earlier this year, they were honored to choreograph and direct a new production of Peter and the Wolf for their dancers to perform alongside the Fremont Symphony at their annual Children's Concerts. This year they also took a group of dancers to Italy to perform and tour the country. Erin and Megan are very proud to be able to organize these exciting international performance opportunities for their students to broaden their dance experience.

Erin and Megan were an integral part of the creation and evolution of Yoko's Nutcracker and are proud to carry on her tradition and continue to bring this holiday classic to their hometown.

Guest Artist - Felipe Leon



Felipe Leon returns for his third Fremont Nutcracker appearance as the Cavalier. Now in his fourth season as a principal dancer with Diablo Ballet, Mr. Leon was born in Bogota, Colombia and trained on full scholarship at Ballet Academy East in New York City. He has danced solo and principal roles in works by Maurice Bejart, Wendy Whelan, Matthew Neenan, Margo Sappington, Lisa de Ribere, Claudia Schreire and Alan Hineline.



For thirty-two years, from 1980 to 2012, David Sloss served as Music Director and Conductor of the Fremont Symphony, leading the orchestra through its development into a professional symphony hailed as a "stunningly polished orchestra ensemble."

As founding Artistic Director of Fremont Opera, which celebrated its inaugural season in 2007, Mr. Sloss conducted Fremont Opera's productions of La Bohème, The Barber of Seville, La Traviata, and Benjamin Britten's Noye's Fludde.

During his long association with West Bay Opera, beginning in 1981, he conducted over twenty productions for the Palo Alto company. He served as General Director of West Bay Opera from 1997 to 2005, and as stage director for several productions as well. He has also conducted operas for Pacific Repertory Opera, Berkeley Opera, the Lamplighters, the San Francisco Talent Bank, and the Oakland Symphony.

From 1970 until the start of his full-time work at West Bay Opera in 1997, he was Professor of Music at Sonoma State University. Other conducting appearances have included the Oakland Symphony, Santa Cruz County Symphony, Peninsula Symphony, ALEA II, Vallejo Symphony, and the Stanford Symphony. Prior to his appointment at Sonoma State University, Mr. Sloss worked as a producer and director for WGBH-TV in Boston, where he received an Emmy nomination for the National Educational Television series A Roomful of Music. He holds degrees in music from Harvard College and Stanford University.

Mr. Sloss lives in Cupertino with his wife, Barbara, and two demanding cats who have no respect for the maestro's extraordinary achievements.






